# OVERVIEW

Rosmini is located on Auckland's North Shore, in a beautiful suburb called Takapuna.

Founded in 1962, the school was named after Antonio Rosmini, founder of the Institute of Charity.

A state-integrated Catholic secondary school for boys.

School roll: 1150 (45 international students from China, Korea, Japan, Thailand)

Rosmini is strong academically, culturally and in sporting which leads to the all-round development of healthy young men.

The school is blessed with extensive grounds and buildings.

We have an 880-seat auditorium, two gymnasiums and many specialist classrooms in areas such as Science and Technology.

NCEA pass rates at Levels 1, 2 & 3 are consistently well over 90%. A significant number of graduates go on to university in New Zealand and abroad.

Our homestays provide students guidance, their own room, all meals and snacks.

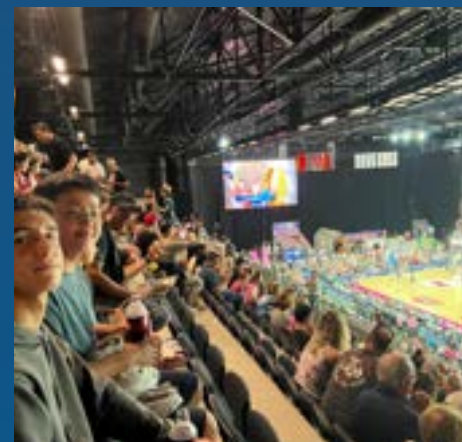
They integrate students into their homes and give them the Kiwi experience!
